TWO NEW SIGNATORIES TO THE RAPTORS MoU

The Secretariat of the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (CMS) in its capacity as Depositary of the *Memorandum of Understanding on the Conservation of Migratory Bird of Prey in Africa and Eurasia* (UNEP/CMS Raptors MoU) is pleased to inform you that:

France and Slovakia signed the UNEP/CMS Raptors MoU on 14 and 15 May 2012, respectively, during the 5th Meeting of Parties of the UNEP African-Eurasian Migratory Waterbird Agreement (AEWA), held at La Rochelle in France.

This brings the total number of Signatories to 40. The MoU has been in effect since 1 November 2008.
