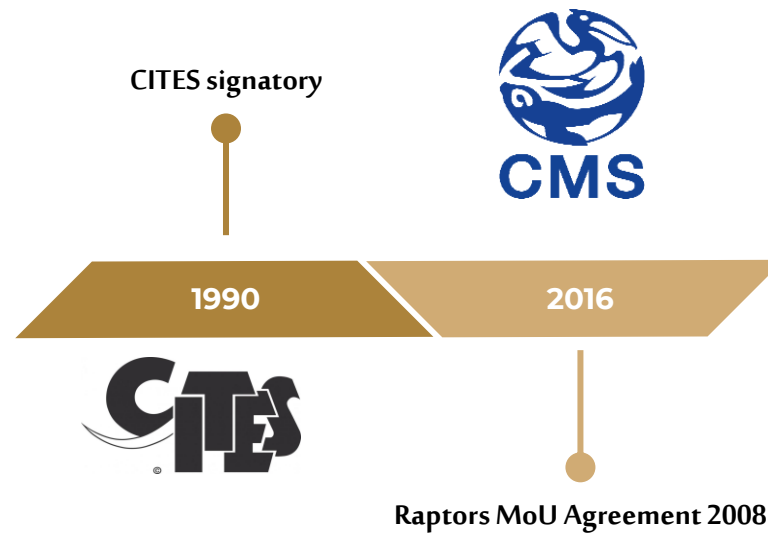


Falconry :A Symbol of Heritage and Identity

- Falcons hold a special place in Emirati culture and history.
- A deep-rooted tradition symbolizing pride, bravery, and the bond between humans and nature.
- Falconry is a UNESCO-recognized intangible cultural heritage.
- The late Sheikh Zayed laid the foundation for sustainable falconry practices.

UAE Commitments to International Falcon Conservation

- The UAE upholds its international conservation role through active enforcement of CITES, CMS, and the Raptors MoU, ensuring the regulation of falcon trade and the protection of migratory raptors.



UAE Legislations

1990

Federal Law No. 24

- Bans hunting, possession, or trade of falcons without a permit.

2002

Federal Law No. 11

- Regulates international trade in endangered species; includes penalties.



UAE Legislations

2025

Federal Law No. 5

- Strict penalties of up to 15 years imprisonment and AED 2 million for importing, re-exporting, or introducing from the sea any CITES-listed species without a valid permit from the national administrative authority.



Regulatory Framework

The UAE has developed one of the world's most comprehensive regulatory systems for falcon trade and ownership, fully aligned with CITES and national laws.

2. Falcon Ownership Regulation

The UAE regulates falcon ownership by requiring registration of captive-bred birds with Ministry-issued closed rings, and provides services for ownership transfer and cancellation when needed.

3. Falcon Passports

The UAE was the first country in the world to launch the Falcon Passport to set a global standard for regulating falcon ownership and international movement under CITES.



Introduced in 2002



CITES-compliant document



Permit-free movement



Includes falcon and owner details



Requires closed leg ring

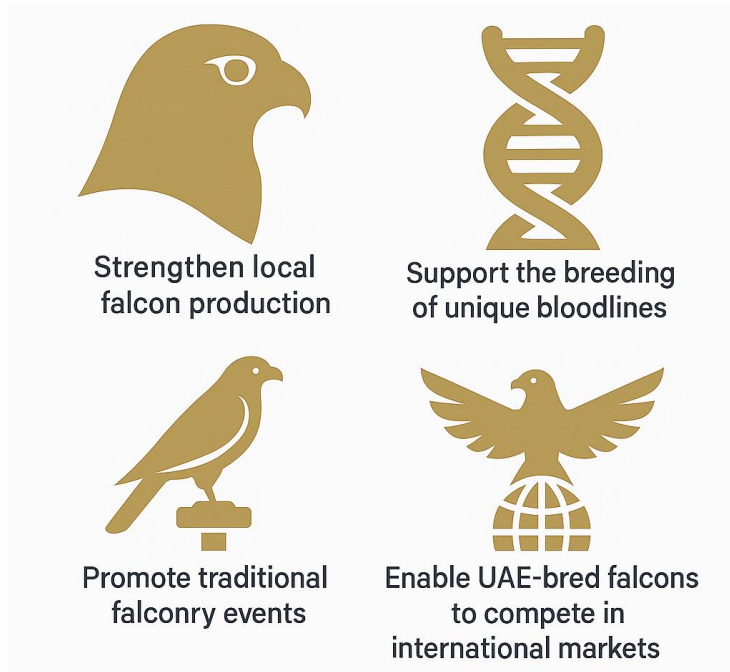


Valid for 3 years



4. Falcon Identification rings

The UAE provides rings to falconers and licensed breeding centers to regulate falcon production and registration, in line with national laws and CITES provisions. These rings—especially closed rings—ensure that falcons used in trade and sports are captive-bred.

FEDERAL LAW NO. 24 Bans hunting, possession, or trade of falcons without a permit	2019	FEDERAL LAW NO. 5 Strengthens controls on the trade, import, and export of protected species and introduces tougher penalties for violations (by at least 4 years in prison and/or a fine from AED 200,000 up to AED 2,000,000)

REGULATED CAPTIVE BREEDING

Only captive-bred falcons are permitted for use in falconry, trade, and international movement, in accordance with national legislation and CITES regulations

Captive breeding is conducted exclusively by licensed breeding centers, ensuring genetic traceability, animal welfare, and compliance with conservation objectives

The use of official closed identification rings confirms captive origin and prevents the laundering of wild-caught falcons into legal markets
