### DECISIONS 14.157 – 14.60 SAKER FALCON (*FALCO CHERRUG*) GLOBAL ACTION PLAN (SAKERGAP)

14.157	Directed to Parties	Parties are requested to participate in the review of the Saker Falcon Global Action Plan during the coming triennium.
14.158	Directed to the Scientific Council	The Scientific Council shall keep under review the work to implement the Saker Falcon Global Action Plan and to advise on the scientific principles and precedents involved, notably in relation to the adaptive management of the species and on the significance of data and information gaps in assessing the impact of electrocution on the viability of populations across the global range of the species.
14.159	Directed to the Secretariat	The Secretariat shall convey Resolution 11.18 (Rev.COP14) to the secretariats of the other Multilateral Environmental Agreements, in particular CITES, seeking their support and contributions to the implementation of the Saker Falcon Global Action Plan.
14.160		<p>The Secretariat shall, subject to the availability of external resources:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) ensure coordination across CMS working groups and task forces and those of AEWA, especially in relation to the adaptive management of species and in relation to the assessment of the impact of electrocution on species populations;</li> <li>b) organize regional workshops of the Saker Falcon Task Force within the triennium 2024-2026 in the breeding range, to promote the implementation of the Saker Falcon Global Action Plan (SakerGAP); and</li> <li>c) review and update the SakerGAP.</li> </ul>
